
The wine cellars' tour: San Clemente "Città del Vino"



We start from the outer Malatesta city wall in S.Clemente, "Città del greenery. Once you've crossed the bridge, go back onto the bike path Vino". The tour goes downwards, alternating between paved and dirt roads until you get to S.Andrea in Casale. Here you cross the district path on the other side until you reach Morciano. Just after the bridge, road and continue towards the Conca river going down via Pian di go 100 m towards S.Marino to the bike path winding away from the Vaglia until you reach the ford through the river. 
